1. Prophase: Chromosomes Condense and Spindle Fibers Form

Prophase initiates visible cellular changes, with DNA condensing into chromosomes and the formation of the mitotic spindle.

- Chromosomes: DNA condenses into visible structures.
- Sister Chromatids: Identical DNA copies
- Mitotic Spindle: Microtubules essential for chromosome movement

Metaphase: Chromosomes Align at the Cell's Equator

During metaphase, chromosomes align at the cell's equator, a step crucial for equal genetic distribution to daughter cells.

- Chromosome Alignment: Equatorial positioning for distribution
- Spindle Fibers: Attach to chromosomes for separation.

Anaphase: Sister Chromatids Separate and Move to Opposite Poles

Anaphase is marked by the separation of sister chromatids, moving to opposite cell poles, ensuring each new cell receives identical chromosomes.

- Chromatid Separation: Movement towards cell poles
- Genetic Distribution: Equal chromosome allocation
