FEMINIST THEORY

Analyzing gender dynamics as applied to power and values. Identifying messages that affect, consciously or otherwise, the role of women and the female experience in the text and society.

MARXIST THEORY

Recognizing there is an established power structure among characters causing conflict. Understanding how societal values and status within the text affect the theme.
