- Both texts 2 and 3 use strong, vivid language but for different effects. In text 3, strong language is used throughout the piece. For example, when the pair are approaching the valley, it states that 'Panic entered the hearts of both of them'. This strong language helps the reader imagine their emotions more strongly. It shows that they were absolutely terrified, emphasised by the strong noun 'panic', and this means that the reader is more likely to empathise with the characters and be gripped by the story.
- Text 2 also uses strong language, in the final paragraph. An example is where it mentions the families' fear that a 'media onslaught' will 'overwhelm' the men when they 'escape from their underground dungeon'. As with text 3, this shows fear, but this time from the families of those involved, rather than the individuals themselves. Using the metaphor 'underground dungeon' to describe their location is striking. It carries associations of punishment and suffering, even though the miners have done nothing wrong. As a result, the readers empathise strongly with the miners and their families, and feeling glad that they are likely to escape.
