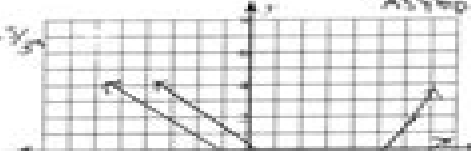

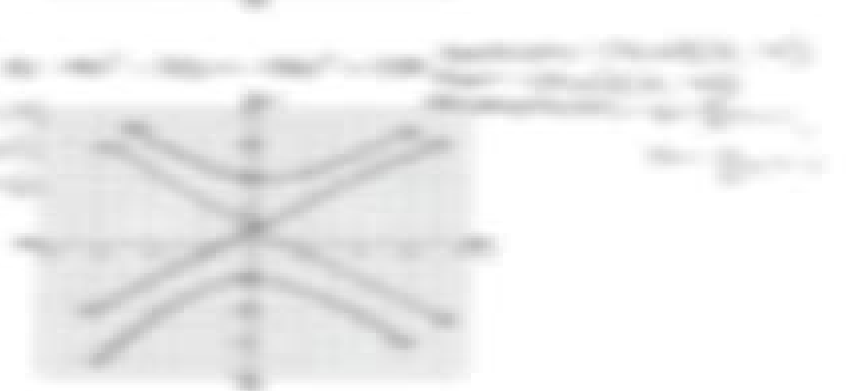
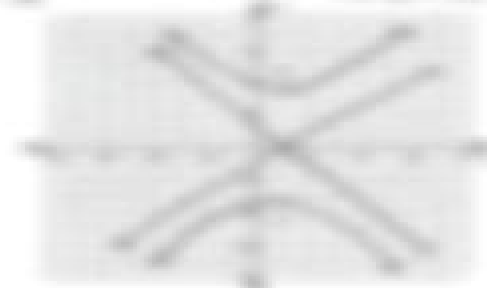
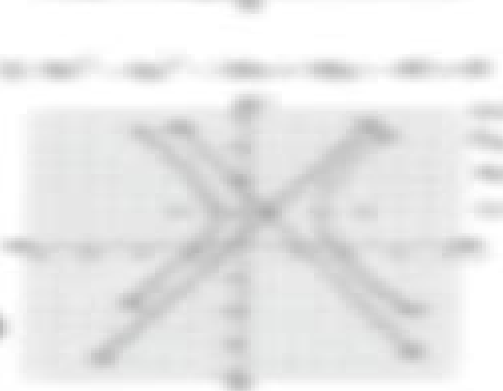
1) $\frac{x^2}{9} - \frac{y^2}{25} = 1$ Vertices: $(3, 0), (-3, 0)$
