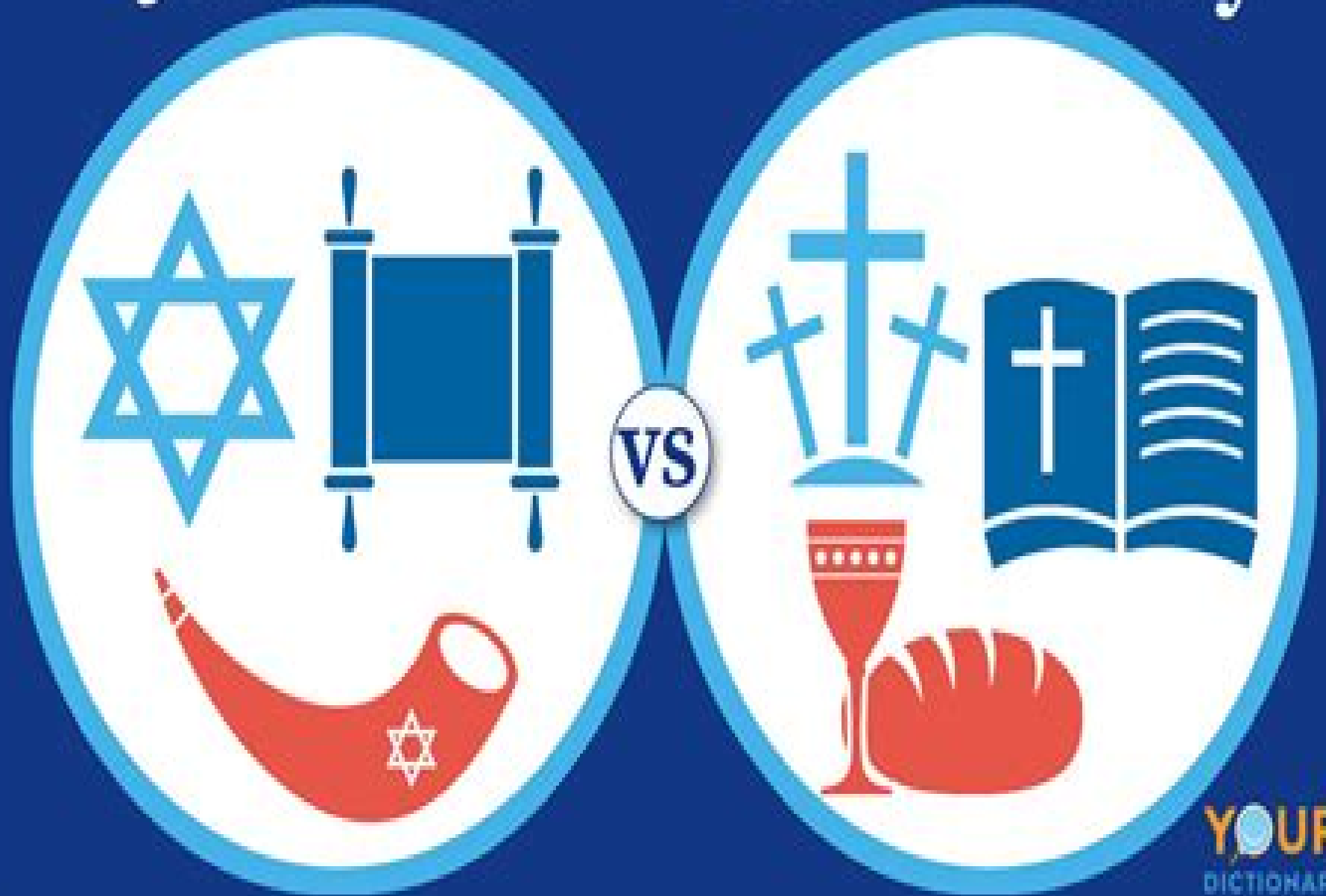

She brings further attention to understudied texts and traditions from Late Antiquity that do not fit neatly into present-day notions of Christianity as distinct from Judaism. In the process she uses these materials to probe the power and limits of our modern assumptions about religion and identity.
