premier roman de Jane Austen avoir été publié après sa rédaction en 1798 et 1799 selon sa sœur Cassandra Austen. Cependant elle travaille aussi dès 1796 *First Impressions*, la première mouture de *Pride and Prejudice*. Quant *Sense and Sensibility*, elle en commence une première critique dès 1795 sans doute sous forme d'un roman pistolaire comme le rapporte la tradition familiale et donc bien différente de la version finalement publiée. Jane Austen alors âgée de 23 ou 24 ans habite encore la maison familiale de Steventon où elle a vécu depuis sa naissance. Elle vient d'effectuer en 1797 un voyage à Bath, une ville d'eau qui tient une place importante dans l'histoire.¹ Le roman est alors intitulé *Susan*. Certains spécialistes y ont vu une référence au conte pour enfants *Simple Susan* critiqué par Maria Edgeworth pour son recueil de contes de 1796 *The Parent's Assistant*. En 1802 l'auteur fait une correction mineure pour voquer le roman de Maria Edgeworth *Belinda* paru l'année précédente. Selon l'annonce rédigée par Jane Austen en 1816, le roman est entièrement terminé et publié dès 1803. Au printemps de cette année, l'éditeur londonien Benjamin Crosby en achète les droits pour dix livres sterling, annonce la publication mais ne donne aucune suite. Six ans plus tard, Jane Austen lui adresse par courrier une sèche demande d'explication proposant une nouvelle copie du manuscrit au cas où la première aurait été perdue tout en menaçant de contacter un autre éditeur s'il ne faisait rien. Crosby se borne à répondre qu'en pareil cas il attaquerait cet éditeur et ne se montre pas très troc des droits au prix initial de dix livres. Ce montant paraît alors trop élevé. Jane Austen qui n'a encore rien publié. Mais après la parution d'*Emma* en décembre 1815, la romancière se résout à ce rachat pour dix livres par l'intermédiaire de son frère Henry. Elle envisage en 1816 de le faire publier en changeant le titre en *Catherine* et rédige une courte annonce où elle exprime son tonnement de la non publication antérieure par Crosby et la crainte que les treize années écoulées depuis son achèvement aient rendu l'ouvrage obsolète. L'époque, les lieux, les manières, les livres et les opinions ayant subi des changements considérables.

The Influence of French on Eighteenth-century Literary Russian May Smith, 2006 This book seeks to establish the degree to which Gallicisms permeated the Russian language in the eighteenth century The largest group of borrowings were the semantic and phraseological calques In order to examine this influence the author has selected scores of examples from the original works translations and correspondence of Russian writers from the 1730s to the end of the century The calques analysed belong to various registers of the literary language from the prose used in essays and correspondence to the most lyrical form found in poetry and certain translations This book concludes that the French influence was overwhelming and fully enhanced the Russian literary language that was developed during this period
