Au 19^e siècle, les Juifs d'Europe orientale emprisonnés dans la prison des peuples de l'Empire tsariste sont pris entre l'obscurantisme religieux et l'antisémitisme d'État qui se manifeste par les discriminations, les vexations et les pogromes. Devant les promesses impossibles de l'émancipation, les Juifs jetés dans les rangs de la classe ouvrière et l'intelligentsia se révoltent contre leurs conditions d'existence et revendiquent des droits civiques. Caisses de solidarité et d'entraide soutiennent les premiers grévistes. Cercles et groupes d'abord clairsemés s'imprègnent des idées du moment : populisme puis marxisme, mais aussi territorialisme ou sionisme. Le corset religieux se desserre, une contre-culture dont le yiddish est le vecteur naît tandis que les croyances d'antan font progressivement place à un nouveau messianisme. Des profondeurs d'une société figée et marquée surgissent des hommes nouveaux qui apprennent à façonner le révolutionnaire professionnel.
