There are 15 distinct sounds within the Måori alphabet. They are:

- · five vowels: a, e, i, o, u
- eight consonants: h, k, m, n, p, r, t, w
- · two digraphs (two letters that combine to form one sound): wh, ng

A vowel can also have a long or short sound. A long sound usually has a macron (a bar over a vowel to indicate it is lengthened during pronunciation, e.g. 'à' as in wâhi). Most constants are pronounced the same as in English, except 't' and 'r'.

The 'wh' digraph originally sounded like the 'wh' in 'whisper', but in most dialects has evolved to be more like the English 'f' sound.

The 'ng' digraph is pronounced as it sounds in word 'singer'.
