Obligate anaerobe - Answer-Oxygen is deadly to them. They lack the enzyme to neutralize oxygen.

Obligate aerobe - Answer-They require oxygen for survival

Facultative anaerobe - Answer-Can grow with or without oxygen

Toxic oxygen - Answer-Singlet oxygen or H2O2 forms during aerobic respiration and can damage proteins or DNA

How microbes deal with toxic oxygen - Answer-They make enzymes like catalase to neutralize the toxic oxygen

Growth factors - Answer-Substances, like vitamins, that can't be synthesized by the organism but are required for growth

Cells in extreme heat - Answer-Extreme heat denatures the proteins and membranes causing them to become too fluid and leak

Psychrophile - Answer-Bacteria that grow in very cold temperatures. Don't cause disease by can cause food spoilage

Mesophile - Answer-Bacteria that grow in moderate temperatures like the human body that cause disease

Thermophile - Answer-Bacteria that grow in high temperatures like hot springs and compost piles

Hyperthermophile - Answer-Bacteria that grow in extremely hot environments like boiling volcanic geysers

Acidophile - Answer-Bacteria and fungi that grow in acid environments that can cause disease

Alkalinophile - Answer-Bacteria that grow in alkaline environments like soil or water
