

Jackie Robinson Voted Most Valuable Player

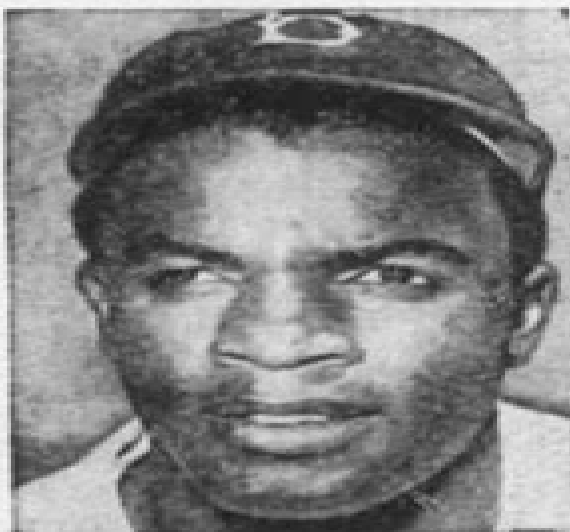
NEW YORK. (UP). Jackie Robinson of the Brooklyn Dodgers, the National league's batting and base stealing champion, Friday was named the most valuable player in the league for 1949, the first member of his race ever to win the honor.

A committee of 24 members of the Baseball Writers Association of America—three from each league city—gave the star Negro second baseman 264 out of a possible 336 points in its annual poll, 38 points more than runner-up Stan Musial, the St. Louis Cardinals' brilliant outfielder who won the award last year. Each writer voted for ten players in order of their value.

Robinson, one of the major factors in the Dodgers' drive to the National league pennant, received 12 first place votes, five for second place, three for third, three for fourth and one for fifth, figuring in the ballot of every one of the writers.

First place votes counted 14 points, second place was worth nine points and each succeeding place one point less.

For Robinson, 30-year-old former U. C. L. A. football star and an army captain in the service, the most valuable player award came as a high point in one of

the most highly publicized careers in baseball history.

The first member of his race to break into organized baseball during the modern era, and certainly the most celebrated Negro player of all-time, Robinson reached full major league stardom in 1949, his third big league season, by batting .342 and stealing 36 bases.

His base-stealing mark was high for the majors, while his batting average was only one point below that of the unofficial major league champion, George Kell of the Detroit Tigers.

One of the most fiery competitors in the game today, Robinson played in every one of the Dodgers' 156 games despite the fact that he was hampered at several periods of the season by arm and leg ailments.

An outstanding fielder, espe-

cially good in pivoting on double plays, Robinson also was high among the major league leaders in several other batting departments. He was second in the National league in hits with 203, in runs batted in with 124, in doubles with 38 and in triples with 12; was third in runs scored with 122 and hit 16 home runs.

In the world series, which the Dodgers lost in five games to the New York Yankees, Robinson batted only .188, collecting three hits in 16 times at bat. But his brilliant baserunning produced the only run in the Dodgers' lone series victory, a 1 to 0 triumph in the second game.

Musial, who was runnerup for the 1949 National league batting crown with a mark of .339, received five first place votes and a total of 226 points, also figuring in every ballot cast.

Four other players were the first place choice of at least one writer. Outfielder Enos "Country" Slaughter of the Cards and Shortstop Pee Wee Reese and Outfielder Carl Furillo of the Dodgers received two each, and Pitcher Ken Heintzelman of the Philadelphia Phillies one.

Slaughter, with a total of 181 points, was third in the poll, Reese was fifth with 118 points, Furillo sixth with 68 and Heintzelman ninth with 48.

Completing the top ten were Outfielder Ralph Kiner of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the major league home run champion, who was fourth with 133 points; Pitcher Warren Spahn of the Boston Braves, seventh with 69 points; Pitcher Don Newcombe of Brooklyn, eighth with 55, and Second Baseman Al "Red" Schoendienst of the Cards, tenth with 30.
