What is MySQL?

MySQL is an open-source relational database management system (RDBMS) known for its fast performance and reliability. Developed by Oracle Corporation, it's widely used for web applications and online gaming.

Querying tables

Get all the columns from a table using `SELECT *`

```
SELECT *  
FROM transactions;
```

Get a column from a table by name using `SELECT col`

```
SELECT Passenger  
FROM transactions;
```

Get multiple columns from a table by name using `SELECT col1, col2`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions;
```

Exclude certain rows with `SELECT col1, col2 FROM table`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year FROM transactions  
WHERE Passenger = 'Airbus';
```

Exclude the rows in ascending order of values in a column with `ORDER BY col`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
ORDER BY International_year;
```

Arrange the rows in descending order of values in a column with `ORDER BY col DESC`

```
SELECT Passenger, Intl_passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
ORDER BY Intl_passenger_year DESC;
```

Get the number of rows returned with `COUNT(*)`

```
SELECT *  
FROM transactions  
LIMIT 5;
```

Get unique values with `SELECT DISTINCT`

```
SELECT DISTINCT year  
FROM transactions;
```

Filtering Data

Filtering on numeric columns

Get rows where a column is greater than a value with `WHERE col > val`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year > 2000;
```

Get rows where a column is greater than or equal to a value with `WHERE col >= val`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year >= 2000;
```

Get rows where a column is less than a value with `WHERE col < val`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year < 2000;
```

Get rows where a column is equal to a value with `WHERE col = val`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year = 2000;
```

Get rows where a column is not equal to a value with `WHERE col != val` or `WHERE col <> val`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year != 2000;
```

Get rows where a column is between two values (inclusive) with `WHERE col BETWEEN val1 AND val2`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year BETWEEN 2000 AND 2010;
```

Filtering on text columns

Get rows where text is equal to a value with `WHERE col = 'val'`

Get rows where text is not equal to a value with `WHERE col != 'val'` or `WHERE col <> 'val'`

```

Get rows where text contains specific values with `WHERE col LIKE 'pattern'`

```
SELECT Passenger, Intl_passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE Intl_passenger_year LIKE '1000';
```

Filtering on multiple columns

Get the rows where one condition and another condition hold with `WHERE col1 AND col2`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year, Intl_passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year > 2000 AND Intl_passenger_year > 1000;
```

Get the rows where one condition or another condition holds with `WHERE col1 OR col2`

```
SELECT Passenger, International_year, Intl_passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE International_year > 2000 OR Intl_passenger_year > 1000;
```

Filtering on missing data

Get rows where there are missing with `WHERE col IS NULL`

```
SELECT Passenger, Passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE Passenger_year IS NULL;
```

Get rows where there are not missing with `WHERE col IS NOT NULL`

```
SELECT Passenger, Passenger_year  
FROM transactions  
WHERE Passenger_year IS NOT NULL;
```

Aggregating Data

Simple aggregations

Get the total number of rows with `SELECT COUNT(*)`

```
SELECT COUNT(*)  
FROM transactions;
```

Get the total value of a column with `SELECT SUM(col)`

```
SELECT SUM(Intl_passenger_year)  
FROM transactions;
```

Get the mean value of a column with `SELECT AVG(col)`

```
SELECT AVG(Intl_passenger_year)  
FROM transactions;
```

Get the maximum value of a column with `SELECT MAX(col)`

```
SELECT MAX(Intl_passenger_year)  
FROM transactions;
```

Get the minimum value of a column with `SELECT MIN(col)`

MySQL-Specific Syntax

Not all code works in every version of MySQL. The following examples work in MySQL 5.6 and are guaranteed to work in other versions.

Get the number of rows returned after filtering with `SELECT col FROM table`

By default, MySQL uses row numbers starting at 0 with `SELECT col FROM table`

```

Get row numbers starting from 0 with `SELECT col FROM table`

```

```

Get the sorted rows with `ORDER BY (col1, col2)` and the sorted groups with `ORDER BY (col1, col2)`
