Beck, 2013-12-02 Durante las dos últimas décadas hemos presenciado un tremendo progreso en el conocimiento y tratamiento de los trastornos de ansiedad. Los enfoques derivados de la terapia cognitiva particularmente han logrado una base sustancial de apoyo empírico. En el presente libro escrito por una autoridad contemporánea David A. Clark y por el pionero de la terapia cognitiva Aaron T.
