Native Son tells the story of Bigger Thomas, a young African American man struggling to find himself in 1930s Chicago. Trapped by poverty, racism, and social preconceptions, Bigger's attempts to better his situation lead him to the electric chair—but also to self awareness.

Escape

Bigger and the people around him feel trapped. His mother seeks escape in religion; Bessie looks for it through alcohol.



Justice

Though Bigger is guilty of murder, his trial is biased, and many injustices committed against poor African Americans in the novel continue unnoticed.



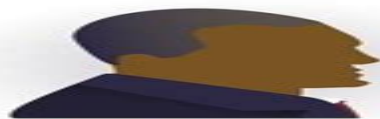
Racism

Having experienced racism firsthand, Wright shows in *Native Son* how it blinds its perpetrators and traps its victims.



Author

The grandson of slaves and sharecroppers, Wright was born in Mississippi. Despite his appetite for learning and reading, he never completed high school. *Native Son*, his second book, earned him international acclaim as a leading literary voice of black protest.
