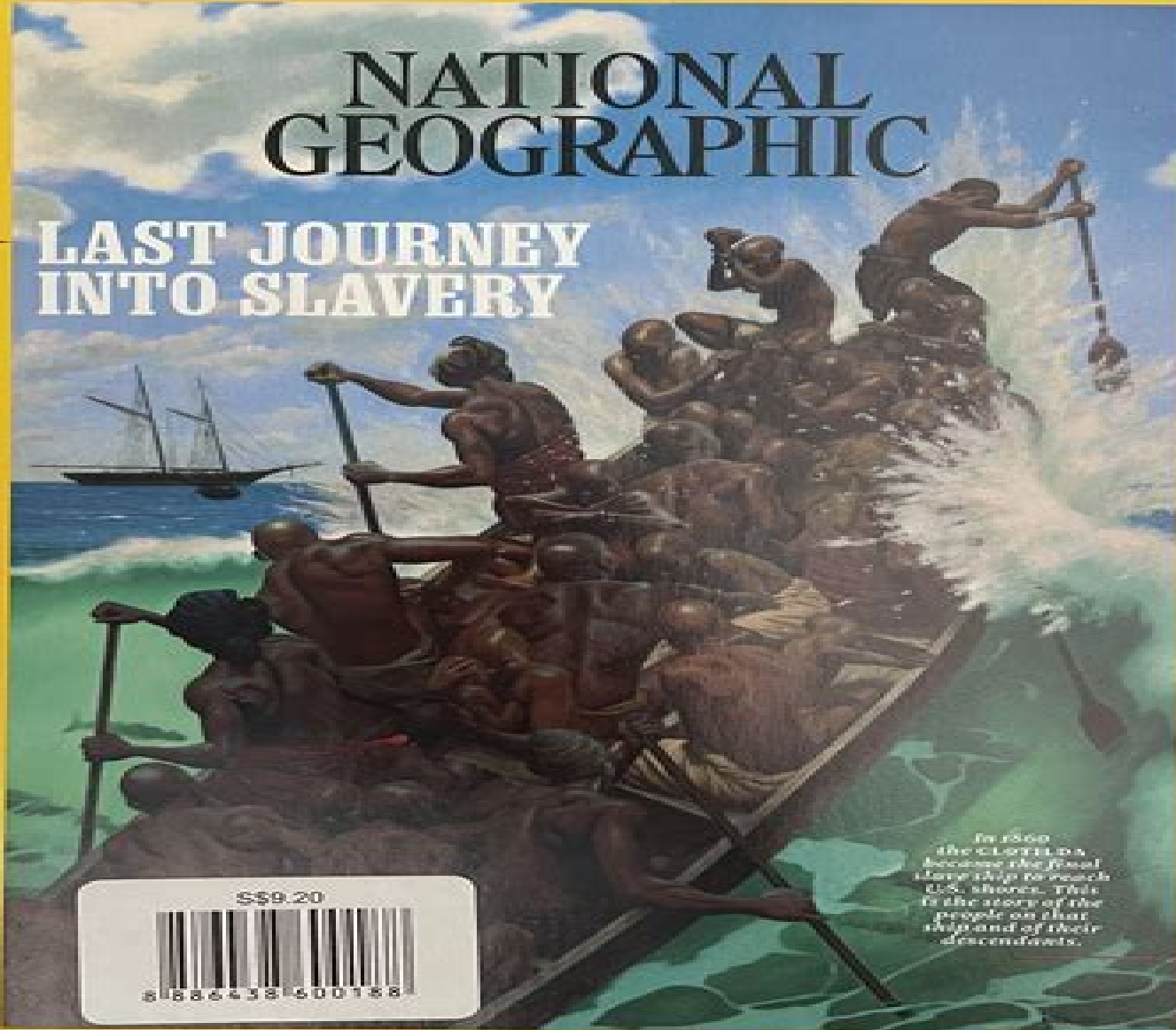

He persevered through prison and refugee camps for three more years, winning the attention of United Nations officials who granted him passage to America. Now a student and activist, Francis has dedicated his life to combating world slavery. He now speaks for the estimated 27 million people held against their will in nearly every nation, including our own. *Escape from Slavery* is at once a riveting adventure, a story of desperation and triumph, and a rare window into a world that few have survived to tell.
