Stevenson In the small hours of one morning I was awakened by cries of horror from Louis Thinking he had a nightmare I awakened him He said angrily Why did you wake me I was dreaming a fine bogey tale I had awakened him at the first transformation scene Lloyd Osbourne Stevenson's stepson wrote I don't believe that there was ever such a literary feat before as the writing of Dr Jekyll I remember the first reading as though it were yesterday Louis came downstairs in a fever read nearly half the book aloud and then while we were still gasping he was away again and busy writing I doubt if the first draft took so long as three days Inspiration may also have come from the writer's friendship with Edinburgh based French teacher Eugene Chantrelle who was convicted and executed for the murder of his wife in May 1878 Chantrelle who had appeared to lead a normal life in the city poisoned his wife with opium
