Immanuel Kant's the Critique of Pure Reason Immanuel Kant, 2017-01-01 The *Critique of Pure Reason* German *Kritik der reinen Vernunft* KrV by Immanuel Kant first published in 1781 second edition 1787 is one of the most influential works in the history of philosophy Also referred to as Kant's First Critique it was followed by the *Critique of Practical Reason* 1788 and the *Critique of Judgment* 1790 In the preface to the first edition Kant explains what he means by a critique of pure reason I do not mean by this a critique of books and systems but of the faculty of reason in general in respect of all knowledge after which it may strive independently of all experience Dealing with questions concerning the foundations and extent of human knowledge Kant builds on the work of empiricist philosophers such as John Locke and David Hume as well as taking into account the theories of rationalist philosophers such as Gottfried Wilhelm Leibniz and Christian Wolff Kant expounds new ideas on the nature of space and time and claims to solve the problem which Hume posed regarding human knowledge of the relation of cause and effect and to have assessed the ability of the human mind to engage in metaphysics Knowledge independent of experience is referred to by Kant as a priori knowledge while knowledge obtained through experience is termed a posteriori According to Kant a priori knowledge expresses necessary truths Statements which are necessarily true cannot be negated without becoming false Examples provided by Kant include the propositions of mathematics propositions from the understanding in its quite ordinary employment such as Every alteration must have a cause as well as propositions from natural science physics such as in all changes in the material world the quantity of matter remains unchanged Kant believed that he had discovered another attribute of propositions which allowed him to frame the problem of a priori knowledge in a new way the distinction between analytic and synthetic judgments According to Kant to say that a sentence is analytic is to say that what is stated in the predicate concept of the sentence is already contained albeit covertly in the subject concept of that sentence The example he

provides is the sentence All bodies are extended which is analytic since the predicate concept extended is already contained in or thought in the subject concept of the sentence bodies Kant considered the judgment All bodies are heavy synthetic since I do not include in the concept of body in general the predicate weight Synthetic judgments therefore add something to a concept whereas analytic judgments only explain what is already contained in the concept The distinctive character of analytic judgments was therefore that they can be known to be true simply by an analysis of the concepts contained in them or alternatively are true by definition Prior to Kant it was thought that all necessary truth had the character of being analytic Kant argued that not all necessary truths are analytic but that some of them are synthetic Having explained that the basis of analytic judgments lies in the principle of contradiction or the principle of identity the task he set out to achieve in the Critique of Pure Reason was to explain the grounds of those judgments which are necessary and synthetic and these he termed a priori synthetic judgments

This is Kant's inaugural dissertation which he had to write in Latin before taking up his position as full professor of logic and metaphysics at the University of Königsberg and which he defended together with Marcus Herz on

August 21 1770 In this dissertation Kant meticulously distinguishes between the sensory and the intellectual realms along with the human cognitive faculties and principles associated with each He identifies two distinct non interchangeable spheres and sources of knowledge the sensual world *mundus sensibilis* which represents phenomena as they are perceived by the senses and the intellectual world *mundus intelligibilis* which denotes the realm of independently existing mental content Kant defines metaphysics as a philosophy that embraces the fundamental principles for the application of pure reason it must rigorously ensure that the principles of sense knowledge remain within their bounds and do not encroach upon the intellectual realm In addition in this work he introduces the concept that time and space are not objective realities but rather forms of sensory intuition for finite beings that precede sensory experience a concept also central to the Critique of Pure Reason Conversely the subjects of moral philosophy are ascertainable only by pure reason This work secured Kant's long sought professorship in logic and metaphysics at age forty six introducing a revolutionary theory about space and time that would remain constant throughout his critical philosophy while developing a form of Platonism he would soon abandon Kant distinguished two fundamental faculties of the mind sensibility which represents the world through singular intuitions and gives us access to the sensible world of phenomena things as they appear and understanding which represents through general concepts and grasps an intelligible world of noumena things as they are in themselves The dissertation argued that space and time are not objective features of reality but rather subjective and ideal forms of sensibility pure intuitions that structure all our sensory experience as conditions necessary in virtue of the nature of the human mind for the co ordinating of all things in accordance with a fixed law Kant claimed the intelligible world known through pure understanding contains paradigms of perfection with God as the theoretical paradigm and moral perfection as the practical paradigm thus rejecting British sentimentalists by grounding moral judgments in pure understanding rather than feelings This Platonic dualism positioned sensibility and understanding as directed at two different worlds leaving open the crucial question of how intellectual concepts that neither produce their objects nor are merely produced by them can necessarily apply to them a problem that would haunt Kant through his silent decade and drive him to develop his mature critical philosophy denying that understanding can have insight into the intelligible world This Reader's Edition contains an Afterword by the translator a timeline of Kant's life and works and a helpful index of Kant's key concepts and intellectual rivals This translation is designed for readability rendering Kant's enigmatic German into the simplest equivalent possible and removing the academic footnotes to make this critically important historical text as accessible as possible to the modern reader
