

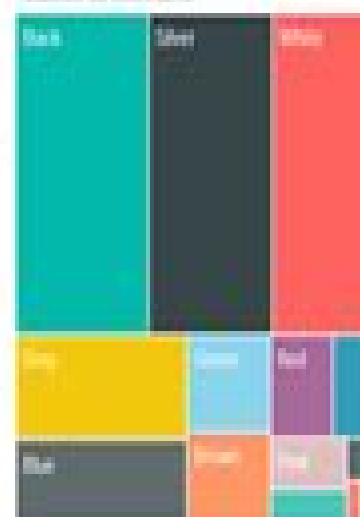

Count of customers by Occupation

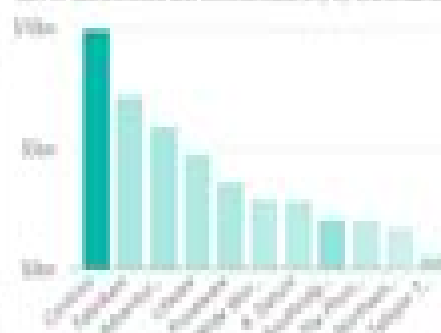

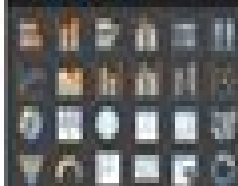
