Eugene Ionesco and Joseph Papp Talking Back to Shakespeare ranges from popular books like the recent Pulitzer Prize winning novel *A Thousand Acres* by Jane Smiley to obscure seldom read ones like Percy MacKaye's ambitious four play prequel *The Mystery of Hamlet King of Denmark* What these published texts share with student journal entries and transformations is the assumption familiar to postmodern readers that Shakespeare's plays are essentially unstable culturally determined constructs capable of acquiring new meanings and new forms By bringing together these two kinds of talking back Rozett challenges the traditional separation between critical and pedagogical inquiry that has until recently dominated English studies
