Environmental Agency, 2015-01-23 Currently the most common form of drinking water treatment for surface water sources involves the chemical physical removal of particulate matter by coagulation flocculation sedimentation and filtration processes along with disinfection to inactivate any remaining pathogenic microorganisms Filtration remains the cornerstone of drinking water treatment conventionally in the form of granular media depth filters Although granular media filters can produce high quality water they represent a probabilistic rather than an absolute barrier consequently pathogens can still pass through the filters and pose a health risk The disinfection process provides an additional measure of public health protection by inactivating these microorganisms However some microorganisms such as Cryptosporidium are resistant to common primary disinfection practices such as chlorination and chloramination Furthermore drinking water regulations have established maximum contaminant levels MCLs for disinfection byproducts DBPs that may create incentive for drinking water utilities to minimize the application of some disinfectants As a result of the concern over chlorine resistant microorganisms and DBP formation the drinking water industry is increasingly utilizing alternative treatment technologies in an effort to balance the often competing objectives of disinfection and DBP control One such alternative technology that has gained broad acceptance is membrane filtration Although the use of membrane processes has increased rapidly in recent years the application of membranes for water treatment extends back several decades Reverse osmosis RO membranes have been used for the desalination of water since the 1960s with more widespread use of nanofiltration NF for softening and the removal of total organic carbon TOC dating to the late 1980s However the commercialization of backwashable hollow fiber microfiltration MF and ultrafiltration UF membrane processes for the removal of particulate matter i e turbidity and microorganisms in the early 1990s has had the most profound impact on the use acceptance and regulation of all types of membrane processes for drinking water treatment The purpose of this guidance manual is to provide technical information on the use of membrane
